How to: Make a Fringed Flower

Type 1:

- Cut a strip 1cm wide strip from either printer paper or construction paper. Then, slowly make small cuts every 1-1.5mm across the long edge of the strip. Make sure you leave at least 8-10mm distance to the base of the paper. This way, you get a deep fringe with a narrow base.
- 2. Starting at one end of the strip of paper, roll the fringe along a quilling tool or tootpick. Make sure the rings are tight and the overlapping is maximized.
- 3. Apply a small amount of glue on the end of the paper and stick it to the rest of the tight wrap. Once you let it dry, you should have what looks like a paper cylinder.
- 4. Gently fold the fringe outwards with your fingers.
- 5. Pull out the quilling tool/toothpick and you have a flower!
